<u>Minutes</u> - The minutes from the June 6th meeting were distributed. A motion was made by Eileen McCullough to approve the minutes, with a second made by Dawn Gary. A vote was held and the minutes were approved.

<u>Treasurer Report</u> - presented by Dawn Gary: The cash on hand is \$18,623.27. The proposed budget is consistent with last year, except for the Main Event. Budget was voted on by the general members and was approved.

<u>Principal's Report</u> - presented by Mr. Furey: the opening of Tackan went beautifully! Buses ran late the first two days but have improved since. With 500 students going to 19 locations, accuracy is the priority. Picture day is tomorrow, September 20th. Meet the teacher for grades K-2 is Thursday, September 21st Meet the teacher for grades 3-5 is September 28th.

Go gold for childhood cancer... laces went home today. There is a site to make donations as well.

Benchmarking to determine reading levels will start soon. NWEA testing shows progress over a given year and lets us know where students and staff may need help.

Red Ribbon Week is 10/23-10/31. We will be conducting situation awareness walks with new staff... making sure they know the grounds to keep the school safe. Reviewing the best ways to handle different situations in different locations. We had our first lockdown drill today. Messenger was sent. No alarms used as there are children as young as four in the school and we want them comfortable. We now have armed security at the school. They do not enter the school unless necessary. On target dates will be Friday, 12/8, 3/15, and the last one is not yet set. These are awards given to students for nonacademic reasons (IE: showing leadership) Clubs have been submitted for BOE approval should be approved for 9/26. These include Book Club (3-5), Yoga and Mindfulness (K-2), Games of Strategy (AKA Ghost), gardening, Tackan Cares, Science Club(SCOPE), Math Olympiads, and others.

<u>PTA Presidents Report</u> - Presented by Michelle Abola: We are bringing back the Tackan Dance. It is for grades K-5. Each student may bring one guest that is 18 or over. The dance will be held in the Great Hollow Gym on Friday 3/8. That day is a half day for the elementary schools. We will have the signups for our

committees out, some also need a chair as well. VIP for chair people... to encourage and thank you for chairing. You will receive a parking permit and 3 front row seats for 5th grade moving up. To be eligible, you need to attend most meetings, be a PTA member, and chair a committee or be on the board for not less than one year less than your child's attendance at Tackan (i.e. if your child is at Tackan for 6 years, you have to do the above for 5 years; if they're at Tackan 5 years, you do the above for 4 years, and so on.) Class parents are being chosen. Teachers choose and then it's approved by Mr. Furey. An email will be sent out by me to the class parents. They will collect \$10 per student for class activities. They must be an active PTA member . They will need to send a summary of the PTA meetings to the parents in their class. Boosterthon will be at the end of October. There will be an assembly with Mr. Furey, and they will watch videos. Cultural arts budget is \$27,000. Carissa is going to do the raffle now for socks, a towel or a magnet.
