- Kindergarteners have finished up their back to school Apples. They
 explored creating all types of lines and practiced their cutting and gluing
 skills. Next up- Scribble Monsters!
- **First Graders** created "Crayon Compositions"- drawing and gluing primary and secondary color paper "crayons" and exploring different types of lines each color could make. They have started making "Crazy Pumpkins"- learning how to blend paints.
 - **2nd Graders** learned about symmetry and mono-printing while creating "Welcome Back to Tackan Tigers"- currently on display in the halls of Tackan.
- **3rd Graders** have been hard at work making pumpkins with dot patterns on them in the style of artist Yayoi (Yay-yoy) Kusama.
- 4th Graders have been learning 1-point perspective while drawing a hallway with a surprise in it!
- 5th graders are using oil pastels on textured paper to demonstrate how light can create the illusion of depth in their "Pumpkins in the Moonlight" project.
